At nine years of age, he moved with his family to predominantly White San Pedro, the harbor community of Los Angeles, California. There he developed into an All-City athlete in two sports. The book is the recollection of a Black skinned child facing a difficult world, both surviving and thriving because of the Christian values taught and lived before him by his mother.

Willie's second book of memoirs tells the story of the relationship between two UCLA Hall of Famers: a maturing All-American basketball player and a developing all-time winning coach, John Wooden. Together he and Coach Wooden surfed the wave of integration of NCAA Basketball.

### ***Poems from a Voice swept under the carpet of the Black Skin Enigma***

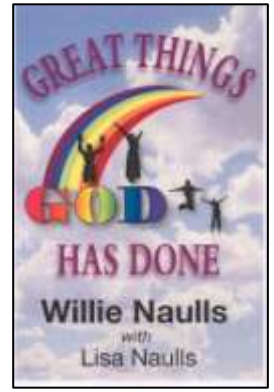
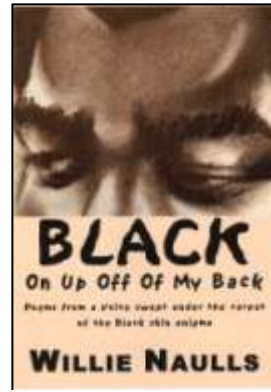
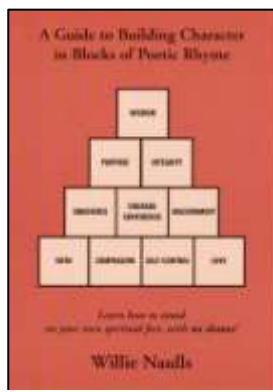
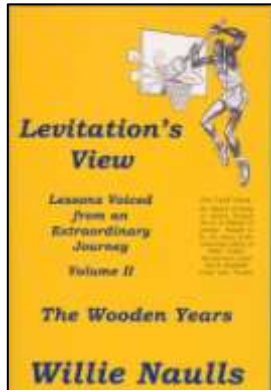
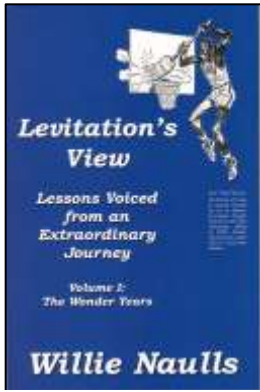
